Presentation

Ideally located on the French Riviera between Cannes and Antibes, Vallauris Golfe-Juan combines the charms of a village of ceramic tradition with the appeal of a sea resort of sandy beaches. Let us show you the sea and tradition, a discovery awaits you with every outing.



In the heart of Vallauris, the castle-museum boasts the Picasso National Museum “War and Peace” in the Romanesque chapel, a monumental work created in 1952. It also houses the Magnelli Museum and the Ceramics Museum where a wealth of interesting ceramic collections are shown.

Leaving the castle do not miss the bronze statue “Man with a Sheep”, one of the rare sculptures by Picasso installed in a public square.

When talking about Vallauris, you have to evoke Picasso, its most famous ambassador. The master attracted by the local craftsmen’s know-how moved to the city of potters in 1948 and dedicated himself to ceramics.

Today still, artists and craftsmen work side by side and Vallauris enjoys the label “Town of arts and crafts”. To discover the town’s many treasures, take the avenue Georges Clemenceau where you will find pottery shops, artists workshops and art galleries. To find out more about local crafts, open the door of a traditional workshop where you will be able to watch the different manufacturing techniques : throwing, decoration, firing...

Do not forget to stop at the Nérolium, the agricultural cooperative, to taste the famous bitter orange marmelade and sample many local products.

When strolling on the marinas **in Golfe-Juan** set between fine sandy beaches, Napoléon will spring to mind. On 1st March 1815, the emperor landed there. Golfe-Juan is the departure of the famous “Route Napoléon”, the first ever French tourist road of a historical nature.

Guided tour of the National Picasso Museum "War and Peace"

The castle of Vallauris, former priory of the Abbey of Lérins, which was reconstructed in the 16th century, houses the National Picasso Museum "War and Peace" as well as the Magnelli Museum and the Ceramics Museum.

Man with a sheep

This bronze statue, created in 1943 and donated to the town in 1949, stands on the market square. The sculpture, is one of the rare statues the artist created for a public place.

Nérolium agricultural cooperative

Picasso went to Vallauris to visit the annual "Potteries, Flowers and Perfume" exhibition at the Nérolium, where the exhibition was held. Created in 1904, the agricultural cooperative still produces and sells a variety of products issued from the bitter orange tree such as flower water, orange wine and marmelade... After the visit, you will be able to taste their famous marmelade.

Madoura, place of art, history and creation

The Madoura workshop is unique and exceptional. Pablo Picasso and many other artists including Marc Chagall, Victor Brauner and even Henri Matisse were welcomed there by Suzanne and Georges Ramié from 1946 onwards. Their ceramic works, like those of their hosts changed forever the history of art, that of ceramics and of course, the story of our town.

Exhibition of original linocuts at the A.V.E.C.

Installed in the former hairdressing salon of Eugenio Arias (hairdresser and friend of Picasso), the A.V.E.C. (Vallauris Association of Expansion of Ceramics) offers the discovery of more than twenty original linocuts.

The day will conclude agreeably with a stroll, relaxation and shopping in the town centre with its art galleries, its craftsmen and shops.

The Pottery Museum

Michel Ribero, passionate about the history and know-how of Vallauris and out of love for the potter's work he shared with his father, decided in 1989 to immortalize this millenary tradition by opening his Pottery Museum in a pottery factory dating from 1868.

This museum, of more than 200m² is divided into three rooms that allow you to discover the different stages of ceramic production.

- In the first room are displayed the machines and tools necessary for the treatment of clay. The material shown, the many photos and archives retrace this hard work
- An original wood burning kiln dating from 1868 takes up all the space in the second room. Everything is ready for the firing, the potteries are stacked, only the few tons of wood needed to start the fireplace are missing.
- The last room is dedicated to manufacturing, with an old potter's wheel, the equipment and tools used by craftsmen.

The pottery tradition in Vallauris

It is under the benevolent gaze of Picasso, a wax replica made by the Grévin Museum, that visitors will discover a rich and varied collection of ceramics. More than a museum it is a tribute to the men and women who have made the city of potters famous.

Guided tour and demonstration of throwing.

Place Vandromme

Cyril Vandromme, a young ceramicist, has opened his gallery in Roger Capron's former pottery workshop, after having successfully completed his degree in ceramics and fine arts in Antibes.

This young artist uses the technique of flate work for his creations inspired by the world of fashion.

"In ceramics, the nude is often represented, never what people wear. That's why I design clothes, hats, shoes. Fashion inspires me strongly and I manage to combine my two passions".

Flate work allows a great variety of shapes, you just have to make a pattern as in sewing...

Jean Bouis perfumery

The “Artisan du cristal”, Crystal Craftsman

Following collaborations with the best crystal workers in France and abroad, Valéry Klein was awarded the « Brevet de Compagnon » (companion certificate) in 1980. He created the « Artisan du Cristal » in Baccarat to continue the traditional work of this noble and fascinating material. Today, installed in Vallauris, he will show you his original creations in a showroom of nearly 200 m². Demonstration of crystal cutting.

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Vallauris Raku workshop

Enjoy a magical moment around earth and fire, experience decorating a Japanese tea bowl, a typical Raku item, after watching its spectacular making and quick firing as well as cultural visits.

Welcome reception in the courtyard of the Municipal School of Fine Arts with coffee followed by explanations on Raku and the workshop

Raku workshop : decoration

Decoration of a tea bowl using oxides.

The bowl will then be dipped in glaze to vitrify the piece and then fired in a kiln at 900-1000 ° C

Awaiting the end of the firing

Discovery of an old kiln at the Espace Grandjean a vestige of the former pottery factory dating back to the great industrial period of Vallauris. The building which has been fully renovated still retains its original layout and big old kiln which can be seen inside in the exhibition hall. Explanations on the origins of pottery in Vallauris

Vallauris and the arts of fire

Visit of the Madoura exhibition workshop

Place of art, history and creation, the Madoura workshop is unique and exceptional. Pablo Picasso and many other artists were welcomed there by Suzanne and Georges Ramié from 1946 onwards. Picasso created more than 3600 originals works there.

Return to the School of Fine Arts to see how the bowls are coming out of the kiln, a very spectacular moment.

The Raku workshop : firing

The pieces are removed from the kiln incandescent at a temperature of around 1000° C with the aid of large tongs, then placed in a recipient full of wood shavings to be smoked before being rapidly cooled in water. The thermal shock and the smoking give the characteristic “crackling” effect as well as blackening the clay.

The pottery is not fully ready before being meticulously cleaned with water which reveals the cracklings and other interesting effects.

The result is magic as well as uncertain and infinitely varied which gives the piece – entirely hand-made - the quality of a unique work.

Self-made bowls presented to each participant.



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Creative or decorative workshop

Hands on clay : these workshops intended for beginners are an introduction to the creation or the decoration of ceramic items. Each participant will create 2 pieces : tea bowls, decorative tiles or plates. These workshops will end with a demonstration of trowing.

• Creative workshop

Explanations of the workshop schedule and demonstration of the making of the chosen item. The participants will then create two ceramics and decorate them using engobes.

• Decorative workshop

Explanations of the workshop schedule and demonstration of the decoration techniques on unglazed ceramics. The participants will then decorate two ceramics using engobes and sgraffite.

The ceramics that have been made will be dried, fired and glazed and will be available within 24 hours (decorative workshop) or 48 hours (creative workshop) after the end of the workshop (working days).

Creative or decorative workshop

Art and sharing : these workshops, intended for beginners, are an introduction to flate modelling or the decoration of a pin tray using this technique.

- **Flate modelling workshop : making a container**

Explanations of the participant's work and demonstration of this technique. Each participant will make a plate using a roller and will carry out these three steps : the cutting out, the gluing and the "guillochage" in order to obtain a unique piece. End of the workshop.

The ceramics that have been made will be dried, fired a first time and glazed. They will then be fired a second time for a glossy and perfect finish. Participants will be able to pick up their ceramics within 10 to 15 days.

- **Decoration and enamelling workshop : the pin tray**

Explanations of the participant's work and demonstration of decoration. Each participant will decorate a pin tray in "biscuit" (a unglazed ceramic that has already been fired once) with brushes and then proceed to the enamelling. End of the workshop.

The ceramics thus made will be dried and fired a second time. Participants will be able to pick up their ceramics within 3 to 7 days.



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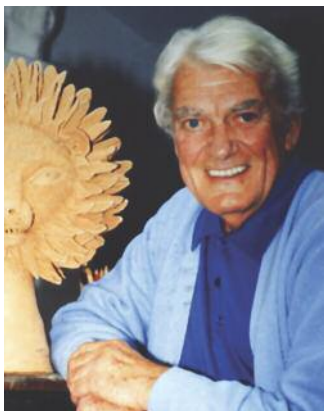

Visit of the old town

You will stroll through its narrow streets and hidden squares and discover its grid style architecture dating back to 1501.

This historical path will take you to :

- the market square where Picasso's statue "Man with the sheep" stands proudly.
- St Ann St Martin church with its imposing baroque facade.
- the former town hall where famous people got married.
- the old cemetery with the tomb of Jean Marais, guest of honour and honorary citizen of the city.
- the chapel of Mercy, part of the Baroque route due to its magnificent altarpiece dating from 1724, exceptionally open for you.

The patron saint of potters “Saint Claude” can be seen inside the church. Each year, during the pottery festival in August, the saint is carried by our potters for a procession through the town to celebrate the pottery tradition for which our town is famous.

Nérolium agricultural cooperative

The Nérolium is the sole cooperative to transform orange blossoms in France. The cooperative was created in 1904 to produce the Nérol, the essential oil obtained by distillation of the orange blossom and has been supplying the most famous perfumers in the world for more than a century. During the guided visit, discover the origins of the bitter orange tree also called bigaradier, its virtues and uses as well as its derivatives.

You will be offered a free tasting of bitter orange marmelade.

Jean Bouis perfumery

The origins of the Bouis perfumery goes back to the end of the 19th century with Antoine Bouis who excelled at the cultivation of plants and noble flowers used in luxury perfumes. Visit of the factory where soaps are manufactured and discovery of the different products of the brand (perfumes, eau de cologne, cosmetics...).

Franck VALOT also works with producers from Vallauris and the area, bringing value to his neighbourhood. Innovative and sensitive to his clients needs, he also offers a range of biscuits without gluten.

Discover the behind the scenes at his laboratory and let yourself be seduced by one of his specialities : the macaroon with Néroli (essential oil from the orange flower). In the shop, you will be welcomed by the smile of his wife Christel.

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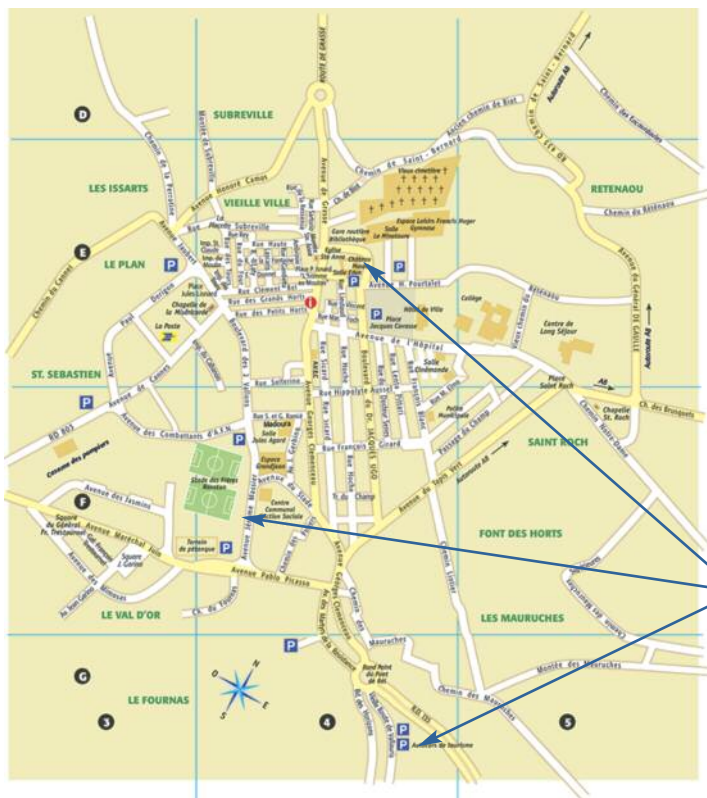
Sales conditions

- **Prices** : all inclusive and per person.
- **Bookings** : will be considered confirmed on reception of our estimate signed and filled by the client accepting our sales conditions at the latest 10 days before the visit. Any reduction in numbers must be communicated at least 48 hours before the visit. Otherwise, we reserve the right to charge the client for the number of persons initially planned.
- **Products offered in partnership with the School of Fine Arts** : require the intervention of a teacher as well as the supply of material. Therefore a 50 % deposit by cheque (uncashed) made to the order of « Trésor Public » will be requested to be sent by mail at least 10 days before the visit.
- **Payment** : the client formally agrees to pay the amount of the service to the Tourist Office at the latest on the day of the visit or on receipt of the invoice for a payment by bank transfer.
- **Booking of a lunch** : a deposit of 30 % by cheque (uncashed) made to the order of the restaurant will have to be sent to us by mail at least 10 days before the visit. The remaining balance will be paid directly to the restaurant on the day of the visit who will issue a settled invoice.
- **Means of payment** : cheque to the order of the « Trésor Public », cash, administrative money order or bank transfer (cheque to the order of the restaurant if you book lunch).
- **Organisation** : an annotated map as well as a detailed programme will be sent to you.
- **Cancellation** : : all cancellations must be communicated to the Vallauris Golfe-Juan Tourist Office at least 7 days before the visit to avoid a 30 % penalty charge.
- **Insurance** : clients and/or people within the group will be held responsible for all damages they cause (breakage) and should obtain suitable up to date insurance cover. Under no circumstances will the Tourist Office be held responsible in case of damage. Professionals working in the tourist industry must be recorded in the tour operators register held by Atout France.
- **Legal jurisdiction** : in case of dispute on the interpretation or implementation of the sales conditions, parties undertake to look for any amicable way of regulation before submitting any difference of opinion to a legal authority. Failing that, the Administrative Tribunal of Nice will be qualified to rule the dispute.
